AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed against the order of the trial Court declining permission to recall the witnesses for cross-examination.

In the impugned order it has been noticed that the defence was granted opportunities to cross-examine all the witnesses who had appeared and no reason was given as to why those persons needed to be recalled for further cross-examination. Even today I have heard this case and on 4-5 earlier occasions also I asked the learned counsel as to why the said witnesses need to be recalled but no reason has been given by him.

In the circumstances, the petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
