Having heard learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner and for the reasons recorded in the affidavit-supported Civil Misc. application, the same is allowed. Writ petition is ordered to be restored to its original number and taken up for hearing today.

CWP No. 13398 of 2011

Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* quashing order dated 05.01.2011 (Annexure P/6) passed by respondent no.1 – Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Service), Gurgaon, whereby

petitioner has been directed to pay amount to respondent no.2 to the

extent of Rs.24,500/- along with interest.

I need not reproduce the facts of the case as the issue involved in this case has been dealt with by this Court in ***CWP No. 7031 of 2014*** titled “***The Branch Manager, Bajaj Allianz Life Insurance Co. Ltd. and another vs. Gurdarshan Singh and another***”, decided on ***19.09.2015***.

The decision rendered in the case of ***The Branch Manager, Bajaj Allianz Life Insurance Co. Ltd.*** (supra) is fully applicable to the present writ petition and as such, liable to be dismissed.

Resultantly, this writ petition is dismissed.
