As per office report, notice issued to respondent has not been received back served or otherwise.

However, Vakalatnama has been filed on behalf of the respondent.

Hence, service is complete.

An affidavit has been placed on record on behalf of the complainant-respondent deposing therein that to maintain peace in the society and harmonious relations in between him and the revisionist/petitioner, they have compromised the matter in dispute. Resultantly, the impugned judgments of the Courts below i.e. judgment dated 29.04.2014 passed by the learned

Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Rohtak and judgment dated 16.05.2015 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Rohtak may kindly be set aside and the revisionist/petitioner be acquitted.

Since, the parties have entered into compromise vide compromise deed (Annexure A-1) and the complainant-respondent has no objection in acquittal of the revisionist/petitioner, therefore, in the interest of justice, both the aforesaid judgments passed by the Courts below are hereby set aside and the revisionist/petitioner is acquitted of the charges framed against him.
