ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner was tried by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC in a complaint case and was convicted and sentenced to the following punishment:-

Under Sections	Simple Imprisonment for a period of	Fine	In default of payment of fine R.I.
420 IPC	2 years	Rs.1000/-	1 months
467 IPC	2 years	Rs.1000/-	1 months
468 IPC	2 years	Rs.1000/-	1 months
465 IPC	2 years	-	-
471 IPC	2 years	-	-

The appeal preferred by the accused was dismissed on 16.05.2015. Hence, this revision petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the paper-book carefully.

Learned counsel for the petitioner pleads that at best it could be said to be a case of attempt to cheat as ultimately the petitioner did not get the grant. He urges that the petitioner is in custody for almost 6 months and does not press the revision on merits and the sentence may be reduced to already undergone.

On the other hand, learned State counsel had opposed the prayer.

Both the Courts below had found that the charges had been proved. It is a case of forgery. The petitioner had twice applied under different names and parentage with a view to get Rs. 2 lacs. He had used the documents as genuine when he knew that it was forged.

The grant was not actually granted. Considering the entire aspects and the circumstances, the sentence awarded to the petitioner is reduced to the period of one year under Sections 420, 467, 468, 465, 471 IPC. The sentence of fine under different heads remains unchanged. All the sentences shall run concurrently.

With the above modification, the instant revision petition stands disposed of.
