JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The present revision petition is directed against the order dated 20.06.2015, passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar, thereby, dismissing the appeal preferred against order dated 12.06.2015, passed by the learned Juvenile Justice Board, Jagadhri, dismissing the bail application preferred by the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the story put forth by the prosecution is highly improbable. The petitioner is a juvenile and a student of IX Standard. The alleged recovery was effected from the mother of the petitioner, who has already been

admitted to bail. There is no other FIR against the petitioner. In fact, the petitioner along with her mother have been falsely implicated in the instant case, who is a property dealer.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner, in connivance with her mother, committed the crime. There is every possibility that the petitioner would be exposed to the known criminals in case, she is released on bail.

Heard.

In the present case, the petitioner, aged about 15 years, is a student of IX standard. The alleged recovery has been effected from the co-accused, mother of the petitioner, who is already on bail. The petitioner is not involved in any other FIR.

In view of the above, this Court feels that the petitioner deserves the concession of bail. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed, impugned orders dated 20.06.2015 and 12.06.2015, of the Courts below, are set aside and the petitioner is order to be released on bail during the pendency of the trial, on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court /Juvenile Justice Board, Jagadhri.
