Challenge in this petition is to the order dated 29.5.2015 whereby application seeking transfer of the complaint pending before the Chief Judicial Magistrate was dismissed.

Perusal of the order dated 29.5.2015 shows that the petitioner Sarabpreet Singh himself had filed an application for transfer of complaint cases titled as 'Sadhu Singh vs. Sarabpreet Singh, Gurtek Singh versus Sarabpreet Singh and State case titled as 'State vs. Sarabpreet Singh' to the one and the same Court. The said application filed by Sarabpreet Singh was allowed and the cases were ordered to be listed in the same Court.

Now, learned counsel for the petitioner states that since he has been convicted in one of the case, he requests that other cases be transferred to some other Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in my opinion it is not a good ground to transfer the cases, particularly, when the petitioner himself had approached the Court and got the present case listed along with other cases.

Hence, no ground to transfer the cases to other Court is made out.
