Instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus/certiorari directing the respondents to consider and include all the categories of disabled employees in the circular dated 16.02.1996 (Annexure P-3) and 17.01.2001 (Annexure P-4).

It is not disputed that controversy raised in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the ratio of judgment rendered by a Division Bench of this Court in **LPA No.1719 of 2011** titled **State of Punjab and others v.
