Challenge in this revision petition is to order dated June 02, 2015 passed by Judge, Special Court, Moga whereby, an application moved by petitioner for accepting and attesting his bail bonds and surety bonds in view of order dated 28.10.2014 whereby, interim bail was granted, has been dismissed on technical grounds.

2. Uncontroverted facts of the case are that interim order dated October 28, 2014 was passed by learned trial Court whereby, petitioner was directed to join investigation and in compliance of which petitioner has joined investigation and the said order was made absolute on November 17, 2014. Subsequent thereto, when petitioner intended to furnish the bonds before trial Court, same were declined on some technical grounds without considering as to what was the intention of Court while passing order dated October 28, 2014 and just on the ground that words interim bail/bail is missing in the said order.

3. Impugned order dated June 02, 2015 is not sustainable in the eyes of law and as such the same is set aside by way of acceptance of instant revision

petition.

4. The concerned court is directed to release the petitioner on bail and accept the bail bonds as and when petitioner appears before it, within a period of 10 days.
