Challenge in the present writ petition is to the notifications dated 15.7.2009 and 16.10.2010, published under Sections 4 and 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 for the public purpose to link the drain.

The challenge was primarily on the ground that the alignment of the link drain as per Annexure P-8 is at 90 degree and at zig-zag manner and cannot flow the water in a smooth way.

An additional affidavit dated 23.9.2014 has been filed on behalf of Shri A.K. Raghuvanshi, Executive Engineer, Water Services

Division, Ambala wherein re-alignment has been carved out again after assessing feasibility and technicality. A fresh straight alignment was prepared and the same was got approved from the Chief Engineer on 1.8.2014. Copy of the re-aligned link in a straight line has been appended with the affidavit as Annexure R-1.

Keeping in view the re-alignment of the drain, we find that the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed. Learned counsel for the petitioner also admits the said fact. In view, thereof, we do not find any ground to continue with the present writ petition.

Dismissed.
