It is contended that the applicant/petitioner would make the requisite representation within a period of two weeks from today, and, therefore, respondent No.1 be directed to decide the same within a stipulated period of time.

However, in case, any representation/appeal is indeed made to respondent No.1, the same shall be decided, strictly, in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. Needless to assert, this order shall not constitute any expression of opinion on merit of the case.
