The instant writ petition has been filed for issuance of a roving writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to direct respondent Nos.2 and 3 to produce the alleged detainee Rajni in Court.

In response to notice of motion issued vide order dated 26.08.2013 by the Coordinate Bench, respondent No.5 appeared in this Court on 23.10.2013 and made a statement that she was residing voluntarily with her husband and she does not want to go with the petitioner.

Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar submits that respondent No.5 has already been acquitted

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in FIR No.156 dated 22.07.2013 registered under Sections 363, 366,
120-B IPC, Police Station City Kapurthala.

In view of this, the present petition has become infructuous.
