SURYA KANT, J. [ORAL]

The petitioner's father – late Constable Som Nath was killed in enemy air raid at Ambala Cantt on 18.09.1965. The respondent-Authorities have declined to consider the claim of the petitioner for allotment of land under Rule 4 of the Punjab Package Deal Property [Disposal] Rules, 1976, only on the ground that the petitioner's deceased mother applied for such allotment on 20.03.1989, whereas the last date was 28.01.1976.

[2]. The petitioner's counsel has pointed out and rightly so various instances where similarly situated claims of the persons who applied in the year 2008-09 have been accepted and allotments made. The reasoning given in the impugned order dated 28.02.2011, thus, can not sustain and is hereby quashed.

[3]. As regard to the claim of the petitioner for allotment of land, we direct the respondent-Authorities to consider the same and do the needful in terms of the order of even date passed in **CWP No. 1567 of 2014 [Jasbir Kaur Vs. State of Punjab & Ors.]** within the time stipulated therein.
