The present writ petition has been filed in public interest

seeking direction to the respondents to prepare a Master Plan/Draft Development Plan of Chandigarh as well as inter-state regional plan for the Tricity of Chandigarh, Mohali and Panchkula.

During the pendency of this writ petition, various interim directions were issued for preparing a Master Plan of Chandigarh and inter-state regional plan for the Tricity. Ultimately, Master Plan of Chandigarh was prepared, approved and notified. So far as the inter-state regional plan for the Tricity is concerned, various meetings of the concerned authorities have taken place and it has been decided that the States of Punjab and Haryana as well as the Union Territory, Chandigarh, will take necessary steps in this regard. Status report in this regard has also been filed in court today by the Chief Architect, Department of Urban Planning, U.T. Chandigarh.

In view of the present situation, we are of the opinion that at present, no further direction is required to be issued in this writ petition. Accordingly, this petition stands disposed of at this stage.
