Inspite of repeated pass overs none has come present on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel contended that the petitioner has been convicted for commission of offences under Section 420, 489-A/B/C/D/E IPC, in case FIR No.140 dated 19.6.2007 pertaining to Police Station, City Kotkapura, District Faridkot who was released on parole on his request by the authorities on 02.02.2015 and was supposed to surrender by 03.03.2015 but till date failed to do so and has placed on record reply by way of affidavit of Paramjit Singh Sandhu, PPS, Superintendent Central Jail, Jalandhar.

Keeping in view that there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, the petitioner is certainly not entitled to any relief, however, on account of his non-appearance, the present

petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
