Prayer in this application is for placing on record the income tax returns for the assessment years 2013-14 and 2014-15 (Annexure P-1) as well as certificate of repayment (Annexure P-2).

After hearing counsel for the applicant-petitioner and going through the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, the documents Annexure P-1 and P-2 are taken on record.

CRM stands disposed of.

CRR No.3158 of 2014 & CRR No.3759 of 2014

Since both the criminal revision petition have arisen out of the order dated 16.09.2014 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana whereby Shivani Monga (wife) was awarded Rs.10,000/- as monthly maintenance and it was also directed that she (Shivani Monga) would be entitled to shared accommodation if feasible or in the alternative she would be entitled to take the suitable accommodation on rent.

Vivek Monga (husband) has filed the revision challenging the said order on ground that maintenance granted to Shivani Monga was on higher side. Shivani has filed the revision for enhancement of allowances.

During the course of arguments both the counsel who are present in the Court with Shivani Monga and Vivek Monga, after taking instructions from them agreed that from 01.02.2015 Vivek Monga shall pay Rs. 20,000/- to Shivani Monga as monthly maintenance including the rent of house. The said amount shall be deposited by Vivek

Monga by seventh day of every month in the savings bank account No.06341140006177 of Shivani Monga maintained with HDFC Bank.

It has also been agreed by both of them that Rs.1,70,000/- (Rupees one lac and seventy thousand only) shall be paid as arrears and Shivani Monga would not claim anything for the arrears except the said amount of Rs.1,70,000/-. Rs.1,70,000/- shall be deposited in the above said bank account of Shivani Monga within a month i.e. on or before 28.02.2015. They have further agreed that it is an interim arrangement and both of them shall abide by the final outcome of the petition filed under Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, by the learned trial Court.

Disposed of.

In view of above, both the revision petitions are disposed of.
