The petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to count the service rendered by him during National Emergency periods 1962, 1965 and 1971, towards pay and pensionary benefits.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down by the Division Bench of this Court in ***Rajinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab***, bearing CWP No.17661 of 2013, decided on 13.11.2014.

Keeping in view the prayer made and the fact that the petitioner retired from service on 31.12.2000, without adverting to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case, the petitioner moves a representation before the competent authority within one month from today, the same shall be

decided within three months thereafter, in the light of the judgment rendered in Rajinder Singh's case (supra), as well as Rule 2.8 of the Punjab Civil Services Rules, Volume II, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
