AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This revision has been filed against the order dated 19.12.2014 passed by learned Addl.Sessions Judge, Ferozepur whereby the application of the petitioner for release of his 32 bore pistol along with 11 live cartridges was rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the licensed pistol was recovered from the petitioner but there was no allegation that it was used for the crime in any manner. Learned Addl.AG, on instructions from ASI Sukhchain Singh, has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances I see no reason to keep the pistol and cartridges in custody any more. The same be released to the true owner on superdari on his furnishing superdaginama to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
