This is a petition for challenging the order dated 05.11.2014 vide which the learned Judge Special Court, SAS Nagar, Mohali, has dismissed the application for releasing the Bolero Jeep bearing registration No. 65-M-3401 on superdari.

The State before the trial Court has stated that they have no objection in releasing the jeep in question. However, the learned trial Court has dismissed the application on the ground that proceedings under Section 60(3) of N.D.P.S. Act may be initiated.

Learned State counsel, on instructions for ASI-Jagir Singh, has stated at the bar that State has no objection in releasing the Bolero Jeep in question on superdari.

This Court in authorities **Nirmal Singh Versus State of Punjab, 2007(1) RCR (Criminal) 986, Balbir Singh @ Fauji Versus**

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State of Punjab 2010(1) RCR (Criminal) 908 and Dalbir @ Pappu @ Dara Versus State of Haryana 2012(2) RCR (Criminal) 495 have allowed the vehicle on superdari till the decision of the case.

So, in view of the above authorities, the above said impugned order dated 05.11.2014 stands set aside and Bolero Jeep bearing registration No. PB-65-M-3401 is ordered to be released to the petitioner on furnishing superdaginama/personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Disposed of accordingly.
