AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This revision has been filed against the judgments and orders dated 18.09.2015 & 29.05.2015 whereby the proceedings under Section 145 Cr.P.C. have been imposed on the 5 acres of agricultural land of the petitioners.

Report filed in Court by the Local Commissioner is taken on record. Copy has been supplied.

As per the said report, the eastern side of Killa No.5/1 was demarcated in the presence of the parties and as regards Killa No.6/2 the earlier demarcation was accepted to the parties and thereafter the possession of 2 kanals and 8 marlas of land in both these killa numbers were handed over to the respondents No.1 and 2.

Learned counsel for the respondents No.1 and 2 has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances, this dispute has been settled and now the petitioners would be at liberty to move petitions for quashing FIR No.327 dated 07.12.2013, registered at Police Station Sadar, Sirsa and all cross-cases as well.

Resultantly, the impugned judgments and orders are set aside subject to the statements made on the last date i.e. 27.11.2015.

Revision stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
