This revision petition has been filed by the petitioner against the impugned order dated 8.8.2014 passed by the learned Judge, Special Court, Sangrur whereby the petitioner was summoned as an additional accused in terms of Section 319 CrPC.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that since the petitioner has been convicted by the learned Judge, Special Court, Sangrur, the present petition has been rendered infructuous. Therefore, he may be allowed to withdraw the same without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner to challenge his conviction that has been passed against him.

Accordingly, the Crl. Revision is dismissed as withdrawn as having become infructuous which shall be without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner to challenge his conviction.
