In view of the judgement of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in **Ishwar Singh vs. State of Rajasthan and others** 2005 (1) S.C.T. 525, holding with regard to *pari materia* provisions of the Rajasthan Cooperative Societies Act, 1965, that a second revision petition would lie, where the first revision petition has not been decided by the Registrar himself, the petitioner is relegated to avail his alternative remedy under Section 69 of the Act.

The petitioner would file the said revision petition under Section 69 of the Punjab Co-operative Societies Act, 1961, before the Competent Authority in the Government, within two weeks.
