The report of the trial Court has been received in which it is mentioned that the appellant stood surety for respondent No.2 for a sum of Rs.50,000/-. The said accused absented and thereafter he was arrested.

As per report the said surety did not make appearance in the Court despite repeated notices issued for 12.06.2009, 11.7.2009, 14.8.2009, 17.8.2009 and for 8.10.2009 and ultimately order dated 8.10.2009 was passed by the trial Court and the property of surety was ordered to be attached.

The petitioner has the remedy to approach the said Court. The trial Court may proceed under Section 446 Cr.P.C. and decide it accordingly.

So, the petition stands dismissed.
