Award of 5 marks for passing the middle and matric standard examinations from a rural school has been struck down unconstitutional in the Full Bench decision of this Court in **Abhishek Rishi v. State of Punjab & ors.**, 2013(3) RSJ 464. This petition has been filed in 2012 i.e. prior to the pronouncement of judgment in the aforesaid case which has brought about a sea change to the relief sought to include 5 marks towards determination of merit to secure appointment as Educational Service Provider. In view of the law laid down in *Abhishek Rishi's case (supra)*, no relief can be granted to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
