Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to grant family pension to the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per the succession certificate issued by the competent Court, she is the only legal representative of her deceased husband, entitled to receive the family pension as provided in Rule 6.17 of the Punjab Civil Services Rules, Volume II, Chapter VI.

The learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3 admits the factum that the benefit sought could not be released to the petitioner for want of succession certificate.

In the circumstances, the petitioner is directed to furnish

succession certificate to the competent authority within two weeks from today. The respondents shall make the entire payment due to the petitioner within six months thereafter.
