Petitioner wife is challenging the order dated 9.6.2015(P-3) passed by the trial Court as also the order dated 12.10.2015(P-1) passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur whereby her application for providing a residence in the alleged shared matrimonial household has been dismissed and maintenance towards monthly rent @ Rs.1500/- per month has been awarded in the proceedings under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act,2005.

Counsel for the petitioner heard at length.

It is not in dispute that house which is alleged to be shared household is owned by the father-in-law of the petitioner-applicant and therefore, in view of the settled law the daughter-in-law cannot have a right of residence in the said house. The Courts below have rightly granted the alternate relief to secure the interest of the petitioner.

No ground for interference is made out.
