Petitioner is aggrieved by order dated 16.01.2014 whereby charge has not been framed under Section 307 IPC but perusal of the order dated 16.01.2014 indicates that the private respondents are being tried for offence under Section 308 IPC.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that it will be open to the petitioner to avail the provisions of Section 216 Cr.P.C to seek the amendment of the charges even after recording of some evidence. It will be open to the trial Court to consider the said application in accordance with law. Safeguarding the rights of the petitioner in the aforesaid manner, this petition is disposed of.
