This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the workcharge service from 01.01.73 to 02.11.79 rendered by the petitioner prior to the regularization of his service for post retirement benefits and to pay the benefit along with arrears and interest @12% per annum from due date till its payment.

Affidavit of Sh. Paramjit Singh Bains, Addl. SE, PSPCL, Rupnagar has been filed in the Court, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondents informs that vide cheque No.303705 dated 08.12.2014 a sum of Rs.2,56,846/- towards gratuity and arrears of pension has been paid to the petitioner. In compliance of the order dated 12.01.2015 passed by this Court, an

amount of Rs.1,40,483/- has also been paid to the petitioner towards interest. She further states that all the benefits have been released to the petitioner. This fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner admits the factum of payment and seeks permission to withdraw the present petition, as the same has been rendered infructuous.
