This petition has been filed challenging order dated 16.08.2014 whereby an application filed by the respondent for execution of the order dated 22.11.2013 had been decided, directing that in order to effect the recovery of arrears of maintenance, the competent authority would deduct 1/3rd of the gross salary of the petitioner every month till the entire arrears of maintenance are recovered.

It is submitted that the entire amount of arrears due towards respondents have since been paid and the amount of maintenance i.e. ₹60,000/- per month is being paid regularly to the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondent verifies the said factual position and states that he has no objection to setting aside the impugned order dated 16.08.2014 subject to the petitioner depositing the above said amount of ₹60,000/- regularly by the 10th of each month directly in respondent No 1's bank account as mentioned in the impugned order through process of RTGS (Real Time Gross Settlement System).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner undertakes to have the said amount of maintenance deposited by 10th of each month directly in the account of the respondent No.1 through the process of RTGS.

The parties are ad idem that in this situation impugned order dated 16.08.2014 be set aside.

In view of the conceded position as above, impugned order dated 16.08.2014 passed by District Judge, Family Court, Hisar, is hereby set aside subject to the petitioner depositing an amount of ₹60,000/- regularly by the 10th of each month directly into the respondent Shivani Saxena's bank account as mentioned in the impugned order through RTGS.
