No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, delay of 128 days in filing the revision petition is condoned.

Petitioner is husband who is aggrieved by order dated 11.03.2014 passed by the Family Court directing the petitioner to pay a sum of Rs.8,000/- per month to the respondent-wife.

Perusal of the order passed by the Family Court indicates that there are serious allegations against the petitioner that he along with his family members used to torture and maltreat the respondent-wife on account of bringing inadequate dowry. Petitioner is working in Indian Army and is owner of two acres of land falling to his share. The respondent-wife has been awarded only a sum of Rs.8,000/- per month. The said amount appears to be bare minimum for survival.

No ground is made out for interference.

The revision petition is dismissed.

However, it is observed that in case the petitioner is interested in amicably resolving the matrimonial dispute, it will be open to the petitioner to file review application.
