This Civil Writ Petition has been filed, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for quashing the impugned orders dated 20.04.2012 (Annexure P-2) and 07.09.2012 (Annexure P-6), whereby, the claim of the petitioner for grant of ACP on completion of four years service along with interest for the delayed payments have been declined and for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the petitioner's benefit of ACP on completion of four years service, statutory interest on the delayed payment of GPF/DCRG and interest on the delayed payment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner informs that all the retiral benefits have been released in favour of the petitioner.

In view of above statement, the present petition has been

rendered infructuous.

However, the learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no interest has been paid on the delayed payment.

In these circumstances, the petitioner shall have the liberty to represent the respondents with regard to interest on the delayed payment and in case, petitioner move a representation in this regard, within one month from the receipt of certified copy of this order, the respondents are directed to pass an appropriate order on the same in terms of **The Financial Commissioner & Principal Secretary to Govt. Haryana, Irrigation Department, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh and others Vs. Hasan Singh Kanwar, SDO, LPA No.915 of 2009**, decided on 07.10.2009, within three months from the receipt of such a representation.

Dismissed as infructuous with aforesaid liberty.
