1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporter or not?

REKHA MITTAL, J.

The present petition lays challenge to judgment dated 10.9.2014 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib whereby the appeal preferred by the petitioner against the judgment dated 28.3.2014 passed by the Judicial Magistrate has been dismissed and the findings recorded by the trial court have been affirmed.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has no grievance to express against the judgments passed by the courts below qua culpability of the respondent who has been convicted for committing offence under Section 170 of the Indian Penal Code and released on probation. It is further submitted that the present petition has been preferred only to challenge the findings of the trial court for initiating action against the petitioner for submitting application in the school for grant of

scholarship to his child which was purportedly attested by the respondent against whom the petitioner-complainant has levelled allegations that he had been impersonating himself as sarpanch and attested various documents when otherwise his wife was the sarpanch of the village. Keeping in view the facts on record, I do not find any error much less illegality in the findings recorded by the trial court as would call for intervention.

Dismissed.
