Instant revision petition has been filed by the petitioner against the impugned order dated 03.01.2015 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, whereby charges have been framed under Sections 222, 223, 224, 364, 342, 302, 201, 120-B, 149 IPC against the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

There are serious allegations against the petitioner. Otherwise also, while framing the charge, Court is not required to appreciate the evidence, rather look into only prima facie suspicion regarding framing of charge.

In view of above, no ground for interference is made out.
