RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks premature release by way of instant Criminal Writ Petition.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto reply has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only grievance of the petitioner is that his case is not being decided by the competent authority i.e. respondent No.1. He further submits that he will make a self-contained representation on behalf of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today, to respondent No.1 and he may be directed to personally decide the same within a reasonable time.

Learned counsel for the State also fairly states that if the petitioner moves an appropriate representation, the same shall be considered and decided, in accordance with law.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice to the rights of either of the parties, present petition is disposed of with a direction to Financial Commissioner and Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Department of Jail-respondent No.1 that if the petitioner approaches him by moving an appropriate representation within a period of four weeks from today, he shall consider and decide the same at an early date by passing an appropriate order, in accordance with law but in any case, within a period of six weeks after the receipt of representation from the petitioner.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
