Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing the order dated 28.7.2011 (Annexure P-4) vide which selection has been made to the posts of Steno Typist by the respondent-University.

The ground taken is that the marks for interview were so high that it could influence and over-come the objective marks. Counsel for the petitioner has argued that out of the total numbers, 40% were for type test, 44% were for academic qualifications, and 16% were for interview. Some

persons who had very high marks in academics and did very well in the type test were also not selected. However, the said persons are not before this Court. The issue, thus, boils down as to whether the prescription of 16% marks for interview can be held to be excessive. In my opinion, marks prescribed are not so excessive as to run foul of various judgments of this Court. Consequently, this writ petition is dismissed being devoid of any merit.
