The present writ petition has been filed for deleting the name of the petitioner from Jarim Darehi Register (Jurma Da Registrer) maintained by the respondents.

The contention of the petitioner is that a Daily Diary Report No. 22 dated 02.03.1984 was registered at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh under Section 188 IPC. On the basis of the said DDR, the petitioner was convicted and sentenced to pay fine of ₹ 100/- by the competent Court on 02.03.1984. There being no provision for deletion of the names from the register, referred to above, under the Punjab Police Rules, the respondents are not deleting the same from the said register.

Reply has been filed by the respondents, according to which, the facts, as asserted by the petitioner, are not disputed.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner was only sentenced to pay a fine of ₹ 100/- and that too, on 02.03.1984, the name of the petitioner in the Jarim Darehi Register (Jurma Da Registrer) is continuing without any justification merely because there is no provision under the Punjab Police Rules for deleting it from the same.

Accordingly, the writ petition is allowed. A direction is issued to the respondents to delete the name of the petitioner from the Jarim Darehi Register (Jurma Da Registrer).
