This Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the service rendered by the petitioner as daily wager in the respondent department from 03.08.1976 to 30.09.1982 for the purpose of pensionary benefits and to pay the pensionary benefits accordingly along with interest @18% PA on the delayed payment of pensionary benefits.

Learned State counsel on instructions contends that all admissible retiral benefits have been released to the petitioner and requisite bills have already been sent to the concerned treasury for

payment to the petitioner.
