JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents to release the petitioner prematurely, in terms of the Government Instructions dated 08.07.1991 (Annexure P-1).

On 07.05.2015, this Court passed the following order:-

“Adjourned sine die to be revived after decision of Writ Petition (Criminal) No.48 of 2014 (Union of India Vs. Sriharan @ Murugan and others) by Hon'ble Supreme Court.”

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that now, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has modified the stay order passed in

Murugan's case (supra) and the petitioner is now entitled for consideration of his case in accordance with the Government policy/instructions.

In view of the above, CRM-W-278-2015 is allowed; the main petition is revived; and respondent No.2 is directed to decide the case of the petitioner afresh, in the light of the order dated 23.07.2015, passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Murugan's case (supra), within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
