DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.(Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing official respondents to release the detainee, namely, Gurpreet Kaur, who is stated to be wife of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner as well as alleged detainee, Gurpreet Kaur has filed Crl. Misc. No.M-14969 of 2014, which was disposed of by this Court on 02.05.2014. Now she is in illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 6.

The alleged detainee, Gurpreet Kaur is also present in the Court and submits that she is not in illegal custody of anyone and is residing with her parents.

In view of the statement made by alleged detainee, namely Gurpreet Kaur, it cannot be said that it is a case of illegal detention when she is residing with her parents.

The petition being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed.
