The petitioner is aggrieved by the decision of the trial Court as well as Appellate Court in discharging the accused in a private complaint inter alia on the ground that the petitioner had not informed the police. Besides, the averments in the complaint are in the nature of cross-version in an FIR registered against the petitioner and others. The petitioner and others have been released on probation by the Appellate Court.

After hearing counsel for the petitioner, I do not find any ground to interfere in the order of discharge of the private respondents after recording of pre-charge evidence.

Delay in filing of the revision petition is condoned, however, on merits no ground is made out for interference.

Dismissed.
