Pursuant to issue of notice of motion in this case affidavit of Surinder Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Police District Ludhiana (Rural), Punjab has been filed on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. It is submitted that the matter was investigated by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Jagraon. The statement of the petitioner-Harsimar Kaur as well as Jasbir Singh, Gurmail Singh-Sarpanch, Surjit Singh-Panch, Harbans Singh-Panch, all residents of village Mallah were recorded. It is submitted that a dispute in respect of ancestral land is pending between the petitioner's father Jasvir Singh and her uncle-Balvir Singh and they had exchange hot words many times earlier as well. On 30.09.2014 petitioner Harsimar Kaur, her father and other family members are averred to have beaten Balvir Singh son of Maha Singh and he was rescued by the village Sarpanch/Panch etc. It is in this situation that Harsimar Kaur in a state of panic/anxiety called the police by reporting falsely that Balvir Singh and his companions attacked their house. FIR No.56 dated 29.05.2014 under Sections 341, 354, 323, 506 and 34 IPC has been registered at the instance of petitioner Harsimar Kaur against Balvir Singh etc. and FIR No.54 dated 27.05.2014 under Sections 447, 506, 34 IPC and FIR No.70

dated 1.07.2014 under Sections 323, 324, 506 34 IPC has been registered against the petitioner and others on the basis of statement of Balvir Singh.

As per the said reply, the present application has been moved by Harsimar Kaur in state of panic only with a view to create evidence in her favour and in favour of her father.

In view of the reply filed, no further order or direction is called for in this case.

This petition is disposed of accordingly.
