FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This revision in terms of Section 401 Cr.P.C. is directed against an order of interim maintenance dated 22nd April, 2015 of learned District Judge, Family Court, Faridabad, whereby, the applicant-petitioner wife was granted ₹5000/- per month as interim maintenance and ₹11,000/- as litigation expenses.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner. It is the own stand of the respondent before the learned trial Court that he is working as a Chowkidar and has placed on record his salary slip depicting his salary to be ₹21719/- per month and the learned lower Court considering the overall perspective and stands of the parties has awarded this amount which is quite reasonable having regard to the present day's scenario of the rising price index and the settled position of law that the husband is under legal obligation to maintain his wife in commensurate with his status, thus, nothing illegal or perverse can be found in the

impugned order.

The revision petition without any merit stands dismissed in limine.
