On the last date, no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Today also proxy counsel seeks adjournment.

It is seen that the present writ petition was filed for direction to produce the wife of petitioner No.1, who was allegedly illegally detained by her father i.e. respondent No.4.

If, Rajpreet Kaur-alleged detenue had been illegally detained by her father, petitioner would not have waited still now for getting her recovered/produced/released, as notice of motion was issued on 26.11.2014.

It is submitted on the other side that Rajpreet Kaur has

already lodged a criminal case against the petitioners and some other persons.

In view of the above, there is no truth found in the story propounded by the petitioner.

Dismissed.
