Petitioner has filed this criminal writ petition with the allegations that his marriage was solemnised with Simrandeep Kaur on 03.05.2015 according to Sikh rites.

In CRM-M No.14719 of 2015, they sought direction from this Court. On 05.07.2015, Simrandeep Kaur was forcibly taken away by her parents.

Vide order dated 07.07.2015, respondent No.3 was directed to produce Simrandeep Kaur in Court today.

On being asked Simrandeep Kaur states that she is living in her parental house of her own with free will and there is no pressure

of any type upon her. The presence of Simrandeep Kaur in the parental house cannot be construed to be illegal detention.

In view of above, no further orders are required to be passed.

Petition stands disposed of. However, petitioner is at liberty to avail any other remedy available to him in law.
