Reply by way of affidavit of Swaranjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Patran, on behalf of respondent no.1 to 3 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Report of the Warrant Officer shows that the detenue was not found at the police station as on the date of the raid and further in view of the aforesaid reply detenue has since been arrested in a case registered vide FIR no.118 dated 7.7.2015 registered under Sections 295-A, 382, 323, 447, 511, 506, 148, 149, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar, Samana, I am of the view that the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been rendered infructuous as the whereabouts of the detenue have been established. Hence, instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous, however, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law.
