The present petition was taken up on the judicial side on the basis of a complaint dated NIL, made by Darshan Singh and received by post as regards the alleged illegal detention of his son, namely, Rajwinder Singh.

Notice having been issued, a response by way of affidavit of the Superintendent of Police (D). Distt. Faridkot on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Perusal of the reply filed on behalf of the State would show that Rajwinder Singh is involved in three different FIRs. The relevant part of the reply is reproduced hereunder:-

"1. *"That on 03.07.2015, FIR
No. 102 U/S 212/216 at PS City Kotkapura
registered against Rajwinder Singh S/o Darshan
Singh(Petitioner). On the same day accused*

Rajwinder Singh(above named) was apprehended by the Police and from his possession Police recovered 300 gms. of intoxicant powder accordingly another FIR No. 105 Dated 03.07.2015 U/S 21/61/85 NDPS Act also registered against said Rajwinder Singh at PS City Kotkapura.

2. *That on 04.07.2015 during interrogation accused Rajwinder Singh made a disclosure statement to the Police and got recovered one Country made Pistol 32 Bore alongwith 3 live Rond to the Police. As such FIR No. 107 Dated 04.07.2015 U/S 25/54/59 Arms Act registered against said Rajwinder Singh at PS City Kotkpura.*

3. *That on 05.07.2015 after the completion of Police Remand of accused Rajwinder Singh, he has been produced by the Police before the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot and accused Rajwinder Singh has been sent to the Judicial custody. At present accused Rajwinder Singh is confined at Central Jail, Faridkot in connection with the above mentioned FIRs."*

In the light of such categoric stand having been taken, it would be clear that the complaint lodged by Darshan Singh, is totally misconceived and false.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

Registry is directed to convey a copy of this order to Darshan Singh, on whose letter, the instant petition was taken up on the judicial side.
