Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondent Nos.1 and 2 to get alleged detenue-Komalpreet Kaur wife of Davinder Singh (petitioner) released from the illegal custody of respondent No.3.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

In para No.5 of writ petition, it is specifically mentioned that alleged detenue-Komalpreet Kaur has been sent to respondent No.3-Nari Niketan by the concerned Duty Magistrate. If the petitioner is aggrieved against the said order passed by the Duty Magistrate, he can challenge the same in accordance with law.

In view of above, no further order is called for.
