RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondents Nos. 1 to 5 to get the detinue namely Ankita Pandey released from the illegal custody of respondent Nos.6 and 7.

Ankita Pandey-detinue is present in Court today. On a specific query put by the Court, she states that she does not want to go with the petitioner, as no marriage was solemnized between them.

Respondent Nos. 6 and 7 are also present in Court.

At this stage, petitioner who is present in Court, seeks to withdraw this petition and states that in future, he will not harass Ankita Pandey.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioner is directed to pay a sum of Rs.20,000/- to Ankita Pandey towards litigation expenses.
