In pursuance to notice issued by this Court, reply has been filed by way of affidavit of Sh. Sandeep Sharma, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Moga, District Moga. The same is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

It is submitted in the preliminary submissions that petitioner No. 2 – Charanjit Kaur is involved in some criminal cases as detailed therein. Illegal liquor is alleged to have been recovered from her possession on 16.07.2012. Fine of ₹ 15,000/- stands imposed upon her. It is further submitted that no raid was conducted on the petitioner's house on 11.01.2015 and neither Happy son of Gurmit Kaur was taken into custody nor he was given any beating. All averments regarding demand of bribe are vehemently denied being incorrect. The present petition is stated to have been submitted through post only with a view to pressure the police department.

Keeping in view the fact that this petition has been received through post and there is none to controvert the averments made in report, no further orders are called for at this stage.

Copy of this order as well as reply filed on behalf of the State be communicated to the petitioner at the given address. Liberty is afforded to the petitioners to move an appropriate application in case any of the averments in the reply are found to be incorrect.

Present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
