Reply by way of affidavit of Gurdeep Singh, PPS, DSP, District Fatehgarh Sahib has been filed on behalf of the respondent/State, whereby it has been brought to the notice of this Court that no such incident has taken place and even on earlier occasions petitioner Kuldeep Singh has moved similar applications which are found to be false and that in fact police has initiated proceedings under Section 182 Cr.P.C. against the present petitioner.

Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner in spite of repeated pass-overs and in the totality of these

circumstances, nothing survives in the present petition and thus, the same stands dismissed having been rendered infructuous.
