The petitioner is seeking a writ of Habeas Corpus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to produce the detainees Kuldeep Singh son of Balbir Singh and Nisha wife of Kuldeep Singh in Court. The detainees are present in Court. They have solemnised the marriage on 29.11.2014 according to the Hindu rites and rituals against the wishes of the parents and relatives of detainee No.2. They approached this Court vide Crl. Misc. No. M-41463 of 2014 seeking direction to Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani-respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents. This order is Annexure P-1. The petitioner is brother-in-law of Kuldeep-detinue. A representation (Annexure P-2) was made to respondent No.2 by Nisha and

Kuldeep Singh that there is no danger of life and property and they now be protected and allowed to go from protection home.

Nisha want to accompany her husband at his house at Bhiwani and petitioner is also present in Court today. Bijender-petitioner is brother-in-law of Kuldeep. He is resident of Bhiwani.

Counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Ram Avtar states that they have no apprehend any danger to the family members of Nisha. She will accompany of her husband Kuldeep son of Balbir, resident of No.220/1, Bhiwani, Tehsil and District Bhiwani, Haryana.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the detenues to approach the respondent No.2 for protection in future, if need be.
